A grade of "C-" or better is required to fulfill areas **A1, A2, A3, and B4 (known as The Golden Four)**.

**Area A ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMMUNICATION AND CRITICAL THINKING:** Complete one course from each group (A1, A2, A3). A total of 9 semester units (12-15 qtr. units) are required. All courses in Area A must be completed with a grade of "C-
