AGREEMENT FOR FUNDING

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts ("the Commonwealth") and the Trustees of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology ("MIT"), by and between the Commonwealth and MIT, do hereby agree as follows:

1. The Commonwealth agrees to contribute \$1,000,000.00 ("the Contribution") to the Massachusetts Institute of Technology ("MIT") for the purpose of funding the "LISP Day" event.

2. The Contribution will be used for the sole purpose of funding the "LISP Day" event, which is a public event held annually at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

3. The Contribution will be disbursed to MIT in two installments: \$500,000.00 on or before January 1, 2024, and \$500,000.00 on or before January 1, 2025.

4. The Commonwealth reserves the right to terminate this Agreement if MIT fails to use the Contribution for the purpose intended, or if MIT fails to comply with any applicable laws or regulations.

5. This Agreement shall be binding upon the Commonwealth and MIT, and their successors and assigns, and shall not be subject to any modification or amendment without the written consent of both parties.

6. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and any disputes arising under this Agreement shall be resolved by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.

7. This Agreement shall remain in effect until terminated by either party, provided that either party may terminate this Agreement by giving the other party written notice of termination at least 30 days prior to the date of termination.

8. This Agreement is made and entered into on this 1st day of January, 2024, at Boston, Massachusetts.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Commonwealth and MIT have caused this Agreement to be executed by their respective authorized representatives.
