EMPLOYEE BENEFITS AGREEMENT

F. Permit members of the staff of DTS to treat students in accordance with the medical advice of the physician or other health care provider retained by the student's parents or legal guardians, or by the parents or legal guardians of the student in the program, for accidents sustained by a student, provided, however, that the sole and exclusive authority to determine the duration and extent of necessary emergency health care services shall be vested in DTS officer and employee.

the same terms and conditions set forth above. Boarding students. All costs for room, board, meals, laundry, and other expenses of a boarding student shall be paid by the parents or legal guardians of the student in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth above.

#### III. Requirements

- A. **Physical Examination:** Every student shall undergo a physical examination by a licensed physician before admission to DTS. The examination shall include a history of the student's health, a physical examination, and laboratory tests as determined by the physician. The results of the examination shall be filed with the DTS office.
- B. **Vaccinations:** Every student shall be vaccinated against the following diseases:
- 1. Rubella vaccination or titer
  - 2. Hepatitis B surface antigen test
  - 3. CMV proficiency
  - 4. Hepatitis Vaccine

#### E. Designated Local Clinics:

- A. Designated Local Clinics: The DTS office will designate local clinics for the treatment of students. The clinics will be located in the following areas:

- B. Treatment: The designated local clinics will provide medical treatment for students who are ill or injured. The clinics will be open during regular school hours and will be staffed by licensed physicians and nurses. The clinics will also be available for emergency medical care.
- C. Referrals: If a student requires specialized medical care, the designated local clinics will refer the student to a hospital or other medical facility. The clinics will also refer students to specialists for further treatment.
- D. Billing: The designated local clinics will bill the student's parents or legal guardians for medical services provided. The clinics will also bill the DTS office for services provided to students.

H. Enforce the rules, regulations, standards, and policies governing the students' participation in the clinical

participating in the clinicals process shall be exclusively responsible for the care and control of all students.

Students shall be required to follow all applicable laws, regulations, and policies.

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The DISTRICT shall procure and maintain General Liability Insurance, comprehensive or commercial form, in amounts and coverage acceptable to the District.

The STATE OF CALIFORNIA has entered into a Master Agreement with the State Compensation Fund for the protection of State Employees, as required by the Labor Code.

The STATE OF CALIFORNIA shall provide notice to students that neither the State nor
